The Changing IEC environment

The IEC environment

CED is impacted by the disruption created by the standard search engines like Google, as well as the digitisation of sources of information which CED used like Newspapers, Magazines, etc. This has also disrupted the perception donors have of CED's support roles in the development and justice space. Support organisations in niche areas are integrating the information work into their system, as the Information technologies allow them to serve their needs in house of on a commercial consultancy basis. This alongwith the reduction of grants, and donation has meant that we have had to reduce our staff. Thus maintenance of the physical library particularly the clippings files has become difficult. It was therefore decided that we should shift the entire physical collection at least in Bangalore, to another institution. The azim Premji Foundation which is well endowed, have several programmes on development and social issues, and thus our past work of documenting development over three decades would be most useful. We have therefore committed to donate all the educational material to them for use of the students, on the condition that our life members, and staff have full access and that the identity of the collection id maintained.

Ahimsa Conversations



Ahimsa Conversations was launched on Mahatma Gandhi's martyrdom day, January 30th, 2020. This platform, created and curated by one of our trustees, Rajni Bakshi, explores how non-violence is actionable and effective -- as a way of life and as a method of political action. A total of eight interviews in 16 videos – eight shortened version or snippets, and eight full length interviews. Each conversation starts with participants' early experiences with non-violence, and how they have work with and put ahimsa into practice through their work in

difference fields. The programme was launched with an interview with Samdhong Rinpoche and followed up with Tridip Suhrud Manish Jain Vibha Gupta Nipun Mehta Fran Tarr Ela Gandhi & Ali Khan.
